NEW CONNECTION FEES ALDERWOOD SEWER BASIN

(Effective January 1, 2017 – Reflective of AWWD Fee Increase)

New or upsized connections to the Silver Lake Water & Sewer District's (District) system are assessed a new connection charge to pay for capital improvements. These new connection charges are assessed per meter size or number of dwelling units as adopted by Resolution No. 674.

In addition to the Silver Lake Water & Sewer District's new connection charges and fees, all new sewer connections in the Alderwood Sewer Basin must include a completed King County Metro Capacity form and pay the Alderwood Water and Wastewater District (AWWD) General Facility Charge before the District can issue a sewer permit. The AWWD Connection Fees, provided on the Table below, are for residential connections and are subject to change without notice. *The new AWWD General Facility Charges become effective January 1, 2017*. For current AWWD connection fees and connection fees for non-residential customers, please call the District at 425.337.3647.

King County Metro will bill property owners directly for their capacity charge.
